Andrea's March Tip:
Review Your Mortgage Rate

Mortgage rates have plummeted. We're seeing 30-year mortgage rates approaching 3.5%, with 15-year mortgage rates under 3.0% and jumbo rates even lower. Note: Not only are these rates changing

rapidly, but many lenders are reaching capacity to service new loans. Some have even raised rates. However, we still think it's worthwhile to at least investigate refinancing if your mortgage rate is more than 0.50% higher than these rates. In addition, if you have an adjustable rate mortgage (ARM), now is a great time to consider locking into a longer-term loan.
